Glory!

This is your turning point. I believe your time has come where a wait for a promise will be no more, but, rather, be the **set time** where you will see His free favors in your hands. This means that your healing will not be something to hope for anymore, but a reality in your body. This means that if you are lacking provision, riches will be set at your feet like the magi to Mary and Joseph just for the sake of Jesus. This means if trials have been pushing you around, then prepare to see those trials transformed into great testimonies. If the fullness of God is yet to be experienced in every outer circumstance, then prepare to experience His Glory!

John 17:22

“And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one.”

One of Jesus’ last prayers to the Father before His death, burial and resurrection was acknowledging that the glory that God had given Him, He has given it to YOU. How? By giving Himself up for YOU! Notice Jesus was talking about Himself; He was about to give Himself up for all your sins. This Glory is the resurrected Christ in YOU!

But having the Glory of Christ in the inside does not necessarily mean you experience it immediately in your outer circumstances. I believe that for everyone who have experienced this Glory inside of us by believing in the Gospel of Grace, will experience an explosion of the goodness of God in the outer circumstances for the sake of confirming Jesus and His finished work to the world – that they may know that YOU and the Father are one, just as Jesus and the Father are one.

Just now the message of the Gospel of Grace is beginning to be restored in full to the Church as prophesied by the Minor Prophets. The Bible depicts this beautifully through the prophet Haggai:

Haggai 2:6-9

⁶ “For thus says the LORD of hosts; Once more (it is a little while) I will shake heaven and earth, the sea and dry land;

⁷ and I will shake all nations, and they shall come to the Desire of All Nations...

Today, religion has taught us that God shakes the world with calamity and catastrophic events that all may come to Him, not knowing that God sent His Son already so all may come to God through Him via His Grace and not judgment.

In the Old Testament, God physically shook the world with judgment that Israel may be blessed. Yet, today, God shakes the world with His unconditional love via the Gospel that all may come to the Desire of All Nations – a picture of Jesus. In the book of Revelation, we find “a great multitude which no one could number, of **all nations**, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb.” [Revelation 7:9]

Satan knows this shaking will take place, so he will do a little shaking of his own to counter this. And this shaking is not going to be “reggaeton”. Satan will physically shake the nations with calamity. But don’t be afraid Beloved....

Haggai 2:6-9

⁷ “...and I will fill this temple with glory, says the LORD of hosts. ⁸ “The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine, says the LORD of hosts.”

While the world experiences Satan’s calamity, Beloved, you will experience Glory!! One characteristic of experiencing this Glory in our outer circumstances is the Church will experience a gradual transfer of wealth so that the world may become peripheral to the Church and the Church may become a blessing for a world full of poverty, sickness, and pain.

Haggai 2:6-9

“The glory of this latter temple shall be greater than the former, ‘says the LORD of hosts. ‘And in this place I will give peace, says the LORD of hosts.’”

To conclude, Jesus said in the Gospels that He will rise up the true temple [the Church] in three days. [John 2:19] So we know that the glory of the former temple typifies Christ birthing the Church via His death, burial and resurrection and continuing via the ministry of Paul, where the revelation of the Gospel of Grace came to its full maturity.

However, the revelations of Paul after he and his disciples passed away, began to be eaten from the Church by the locust from generation to generation, resulting in the New Wine [The Gospel of Grace] being cut off from the Church. [Joel 1:3-10]

The glory of the latter temple typifies the end time glorious Church, where the Gospel of Grace has been restored back to its totality! Even in the context, the children of Israel had been restored back to the Promised Land (after being exiled in Babylon for many years), which is a picture of the Church regaining the revelation of being righteous by faith.
